A dispute resolution clause is essential to resolving disputes outside of national courts. Whilst there is no “standard” dispute resolution clause *per se*, drafting a proper clause contributes to managing the risks and costs associated with dispute resolution. In this CPD seminar, the speakers will examine various pre-dispute resolution considerations, the requirements of a valid arbitration clause, as well as various considerations when drafting an arbitration clause, including selection of the procedural law, governing law, number of arbitrators etc.
